The name and telephone number of the Home Contact is on the permission form. This is a named adult who will be on call for the duration of the sleepover to take calls from parents or guardians who need to contact the camp *in an emergency*. They also have contact details for all parents of children on the activity and will call parents to relay information from the camp (such as a change in pick up time) if the need arises. This takes the pressure off leaders who are then free to deal with whatever situation may have arisen on the trip.
